"Dr. Rachlin embarked on his thirty-year legal career by first serving as a law clerk to a United States District Court Judge. He then went on to become an Assistant Attorney General for the State of Florida, prosecuting cases in the areas of antitrust, consumer protection and deceptive trade practice. One of his more memorable cases was when he, on behalf of Florida, brought suit and secured a judgement against President Richard Nixon for the president's refusal to spend funds appropriated by congress for the clean-up of coastal waters. During his extensive career, which includes eight years of teaching at the university level, Dr. Rachlin has represented Fortune 500 companies, their presidents and CEO's. In such representation, he would always stress the importance of leadership-type communication in every business setting, as well as the ways in which to effectively negotiate when disputes inevitably arise."
