Course Description:

Intensive English Program (IEP) 2 - Conversation / Speech

Students will advance in fluency and oral comprehension of English sentences. Students participate in oral exercise using American idioms and participate in discussions of relevant subjects and present short prepared speeches.

Objectives:

To help students to speak English intelligibly—with acceptable pronunciation and enunciation of English words—and to comprehend what they and the teacher say.

We discuss at each session all interesting and relevant topics on our minds. The discussions are frequently broken off with teacher's corrections and explanations of English speech.

Evaluation:

Students' progress, or lack of it, is obvious to both the students and the teacher.
